Safety Information:

- Check all parts for shipping damage and test all the function before using.
- Before moving the bed, the plug <u>MUST</u> be removed from the power point. Always keep the cable clear from the floor and castors during transportation.
- DO NOT use the bed for transporting a patient. Otherwise, injury or damage may occur.
- When the bed is used with children under 12 years, psychiatric patients and physically challenged individuals, close supervision is required.
- The bed is for nursing use only.
- DO NOT allow any individual under the bed at ANY time.
- Extra care should be taken to ensure spills are avoided, when using liquids in or around the bed. If a liquid is spilt on the bed, UNPLUG the bed immediately. Wipe the spill with a dry towel. DO NOT use the bed until the bed is dried thoroughly.
 - The castors MUST be all locked before putting a patient onto the bed.
- Ensure all moving parts, including the mattress platform, main frame and moving actuators are free of obstruction (i.e. bed sheets, blankets, drainage bags/tubing, and other products with electric cords which can get tangled with the frames, safety rails, limbs and etc.) during operation.
- In order to reduce the risk of electric shock, DO NOT use the bed outdoors or on wet surfaces. It is not suitable for use in the presence of a flammable reagent.



Following illustrations show a castor at locked and unlocked position:




Central Locking Systems

TERMS OF WARRANTY

1 YEARS WARRANTY ON MOTOR, CONTROL BOX, AND ACTUATORS 5 YEARS WARRANTY ON STRUCTURE 6 MONTHS WARRANTY ON HANDSET

Should a defect in this due to either FAULTY MATERIAL or WORKMANSHIP become apparent within the above period from the date of delivery of the product, such defect will be rectified by the authorized service centre, without cost to you for either labor or material, at the premise of the distributor, subject to:

- 1. The Warranty being rendered invalid if the product is misused or if any unauthorized alteration, modification, or substitution of any part of the product be made or the serial number is lost or altered.
- 2. Cost of transportation both ways to and from the authorized service centre being met by the owner if returning the product or any part to the authorized service centre is necessary.
- 3. The warranty only applying to the servicing within Australia of products purchased in Australia.
- 4. All (a) damage resulting from incorrect installation or use other than in accordance with the operating instructions issued by the manufacturer (b) consequential damage, being excluded from this Warranty.
- 5. A charge being accepted by the owner for traveling expenses incurred in connection with warranty services at the user's premises.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

- 1. Warranty starts from the date of delivery.
- 2. If the product or any parts returned to the authorized service centre for any cause not covered by this warranty, all costs involved, must be paid to the authorized service centre.
- 3. Changes not covered by the term of this Warranty must be borne by the owner. Such charges may arise through the cost of any service call where (a) the product is found to be in incorrect installation, maladjustment of user controls, or failure to follow operating instructions.
